

# The Economic Impact of California High-Speed Rail

From July 2006 through June 2017, the California High-Speed Rail Authority has invested over **\$3.5 billion** in planning and constructing the nation's first high-speed rail system.

## 54%

of project expenditure occurred in designated disadvantaged communities throughout California, spurring economic activity in these areas.
