

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Road Closures At Chestnut And Mountain View Avenues In Fresno County

Fresno County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces road closures along Chestnut Avenue, between Nebraska and Kamm avenues; and Mountain View Avenue, between Cedar and Peach avenues, in Fresno County for the next phase of high-speed rail construction. Work includes the construction of a high-speed rail overcrossing. Work will continue through October 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Road Closures along Chestnut Avenue, between Nebraska and Kamm avenues; and Mountain View Avenue, between Cedar and Peach avenues, in Fresno County. Work includes the construction of a high-speed rail overcrossing.

Work will continue through October 2024.

Northbound Traffic (Chestnut Avenue)

Traffic going northbound on Chestnut Ave will be detoured west on Conejo Avenue, north on Cedar

Avenue, east on Nebraska Avenue, then north on Chestnut Avenue.

Southbound Traffic (Chestnut Avenue)

Traffic going southbound on Chestnut Avenue will be detoured west on Nebraska Avenue, south on Cedar Avenue, east on Conejo Avenue, then south on Chestnut Avenue.

Eastbound Traffic (Mountain View Avenue)

Traffic going eastbound on Mountain View

Avenue will be detoured north on Cedar Avenue, east on Nebraska Avenue, south on Peach Avenue, then east on Mountain View Avenue.

Westbound Traffic (Mountain View Avenue)

Traffic going westbound on Mountain View Avenue will be detoured north on Peach Avenue, west on Nebraska Avenue, south on Cedar Avenue, then west on Mountain View Avenue.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic.
