

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Multiple Closures Along Olive And Weber Avenues In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closure along Olive and Weber avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to start Monday, Feb. 5 and will continue through Friday, May 10, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Closures:

- Intermittent lane and shoulder closures along Weber Avenue, north of Olive Avenue;
- Lane closure along Olive Avenue, between Weber and Fruit avenues.

Work is scheduled to start Monday, Feb. 5 and will continue through Friday, May 10, 2024.

Northbound Weber Avenue Detour

Traffic heading to northbound Weber Avenue

from Olive Avenue will be detoured northbound on Golden state Boulevard to McKinley Avenue.

Southbound Weber Avenue Detour

Traffic heading southbound to Weber Avenue will be detoured south on Golden State Boulevard, then east along Olive Avenue to Weber Avenue.

Eastbound Olive Avenue Detour

Traffic heading eastbound on Olive Avenue will be detoured north on Golden State Boulevard, east on McKinley Avenue, south on Palm Avenue, then east on Olive Avenue.

Westbound Olive Avenue Detour

Traffic heading westbound on Olive Avenue will be detoured north on Palm Avenue, west on McKinley Avenue, south on Golden State Boulevard, then west on Olive Avenue.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic.

Access will be maintained for all businesses and property owners.
