NEW TRAFFIC PATTERN ALONG AVENUE 56 IN TULARE COUNTY

TULARE COUNTY, CALIF. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces a new traffic pattern along Avenue 56, between State Route 43 (SR) and Road 64 in Tulare County for work on a high-speed rail structure. The new traffic pattern will direct traffic slightly south along a bypass road and will go into effect on Tuesday, Aug. 23, 2022 until further notice.

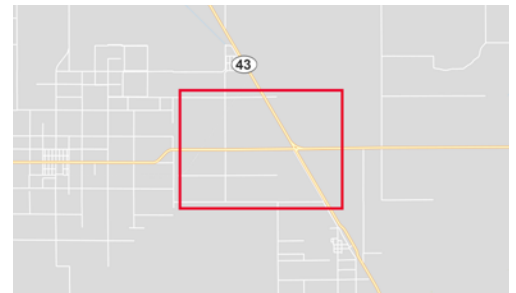
This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

CLOSURE AND DETOUR INFORMATION:
