Lane Closure Along H Street In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a lane closure along H Street, north and south of Roosevelt Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work will continue through Friday, March 20, 2026.


This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Lane closure along H Street, north and south of Roosevelt Avenue in Fresno for utility work.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all property and business owners in the area.

Work will continue through Friday, March 20, 2026.



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
