



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

LANE CLOSURES ALONG SOUTH AVENUE IN FRESNO COUNTY

FRESNO COUNTY, CALIF. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor, Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV) announces lane closures along South Avenue, between Cedar and Maple avenues in Fresno County for utility work. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, May 22 and will continue through Saturday, June 3, 2023.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

CLOSURE AND DETOUR INFORMATION:

Lane closures along South Avenue, between Cedar and Maple avenues in Fresno County for utility work.

Work is scheduled to begin Monday, May 22 and will continue through Saturday, June 3, 2023.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic.

Access will be maintained for all property and business owners.
