

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

INTERMITTENT LANE AND SHOULDER CLOSURES ALONG BELMONT AVENUE IN FRESNO

FRESNO, CALIF. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces intermittent lane and shoulder closures along Belmont Avenue, between Parkview Drive and Teilman Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting on Monday, May 22 through Friday, May 26, 2023.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

CLOSURE AND DETOUR INFORMATION:

Intermittent lane and shoulder closures along Belmont Avenue, between Parkview Drive and Teilman Avenue in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting on Monday, May 22 through Friday, May 26, 2023.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Pedestrian access will be restricted. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.
