



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

LANE CLOSURES ALONG CORNELIA AVENUE IN FRESNO

FRESNO, CALIF. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane closures along Cornelia Avenue between Shaw Avenue and Golden State Boulevard in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to begin Monday May 8 and will continue through Tuesday, August 1, 2023.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

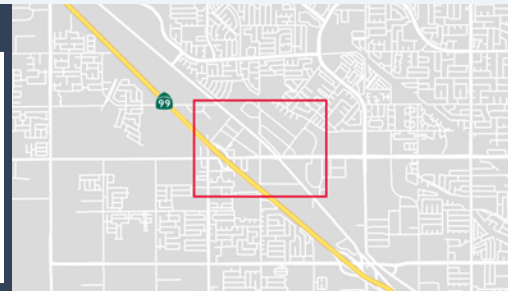
CLOSURE AND DETOUR INFORMATION:

Lane closures along Cornelia Avenue between Shaw Avenue and Golden State Boulevard in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled to begin Monday, May 8, and will continue through Tuesday, August 1, 2023.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic.

Access will be maintained to all property and business owners.
