

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

MULTIPLE CLOSURES ALONG EAST AVENUE AND GOLDEN STATE BOULEVARD IN FRESNO

FRESNO, CALIF. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along East Avenue and Golden State Boulevard in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Friday, June 9 through Thursday, July 20, 2023.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

CLOSURE AND DETOUR INFORMATION:

MULTIPLE CLOSURES:

- Lane closures along East Avenue, between Railroad Avenue and Golden State Boulevard;
- Lane closures along Golden State Boulevard, between Church and Jensen avenues.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Friday, June 9 through Thursday, July 20, 2023.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.
