Lane Closures Along H Street In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane closures along H Street, between Harrison Avenue and Divisadero Street in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 8 p.m. to 8 a.m. starting Sunday, Jan. 14 through Thursday, March 14, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.
