Intermittent Traffic Impacts Along Seventh And Fargo Avenues In Kings County

Kings County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along Seventh and Fargo avenues in Kings County to transport embankment fill for high-speed rail construction. Hauling is scheduled from 5:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Wednesday, Aug. 23 through Wednesday, Sept. 27, 2023.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along Seventh and Fargo avenues in Kings County to transport embankment fill for high-speed rail construction.

Hauling is scheduled from 5:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Wednesday, Aug. 23 through Wednesday, Sept. 27, 2023.

Haul Route

The embankment haul will begin just South of Dover Avenue at Seventh Avenue. Trucks will travel south on Seventh Avenue, then west on Fargo Avenue to 7 % Avenue.
