## Intermittent Traffic Impacts Along Seventh And Fargo Avenues In Kings County

**Kings County, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along Seventh and Fargo avenues in Kings County to transport embankment fill for high-speed rail construction. Hauling is scheduled from 5:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Wednesday, Aug. 23 through Wednesday, Sept. 27, 2023.

*This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.*

### Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along Seventh and Fargo avenues in Kings County to transport embankment fill for high-speed rail construction.

**Hauling is scheduled from 5:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Wednesday, Aug. 23 through Wednesday, Sept. 27, 2023.**

#### Haul Route

The embankment haul will begin just South of Dover Avenue at Seventh Avenue. Trucks will travel south on Seventh Avenue, then west on Fargo Avenue to 7 ½ Avenue.

**Access will be maintained for all property and business owners.**
