

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Multiple Lane Closures Along Barstow Avenue And Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple lane closures along Barstow Avenue and Golden State Boulevard in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Aug. 21 through Friday, Aug. 25, 2023.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

 Lane closures along Barstow Avenue between San Madele Avenue and Golden State Boulevard;

Lane closures along Golden State Boulevard, north of Barstow Avenue
