

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Road Closure Along Cornelia Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a road closure along Cornelia Avenue, north of Shaw Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work will continue through Friday, Sept. 1, 2023.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Road closure along Cornelia Avenue, north of Shaw Avenue in Fresno for utility work.

Work will continue through Friday, Sept. 1, 2023.

Northbound Cornelia Avenue Detour: Traffic going north on Cornelia Avenue will be

detoured east on Shaw Avenue, then north on Golden State Boulevard to Cornelia Avenue.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Access to driveways will be maintained for all property owners.
