Lane Closures Along Southbound Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane closures along southbound Golden State Boulevard, between Richert and Swift avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Aug. 14 through Friday, Aug. 25, 2023.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Lane closures along southbound Golden State Boulevard, between Richert and Swift avenues in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Aug, 14, through Friday, Aug. 25, 2023.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all business and property owners.





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
