
Lane Closures Along Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane closures along Golden State Boulevard, between the State Route (SR) 99 on-ramp and Olive Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to begin Wednesday, Jan. 3 and will continue through Thursday, Feb. 29, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Lane closures along Golden State Boulevard, between the SR 99 on-ramp and Olive Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to begin Wednesday, Jan. 3 and will continue through Thursday, Feb. 29, 2024. Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.
