## **Shoulder Closures Along Weber Avenue In Fresno**

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces shoulder closures along Weber Avenue between Brooks and Floradora avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to continue through Friday, Nov. 21, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

## **Closure And Detour Information:**

Shoulder closures along Weber Avenue between Brooks and Floradora avenues in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled to continue through Friday, Nov. 21, 2025.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained for all property and business owners. Pedestrian access will be restricted.
