## Intermittent Lane Closures Along State Route 198 In Kings County

Kings County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent lane closures along State Route (SR) 198, between SR 43 and Sixth Avenue in Kings County for work on the Hanford Viaduct. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, Nov. 13 and will continue through Friday, Nov. 17, 2023.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

## Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent lane closures along eastbound SR 198, between SR 43 and Sixth Avenue in Kings County. Work is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Monday, Nov. 13 and Tuesday, Nov. 14, 2023.

Intermittent lane closures along eastbound and westbound SR 198, between SR 43 and Sixth Avenue in Kings County. Work is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Wednesday, Nov. 15 through Friday, Nov. 17, 2023.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic.
