Intermittent Lane Closures Along Weber Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces intermittent lane closures along Weber Avenue, between Fruit and Vagedes avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Nov. 13 through Wednesday, Dec. 13, 2023.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent lane closures along Weber Avenue, between Fruit and Vagedes avenues in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Nov. 13 through Wednesday, Dec. 13, 2023.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.
