Lane Closures Along Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane closures along Golden State Boulevard, between Richert and Swift avenues in Fresno for road work. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, March 2 and will continue through Tuesday, March 17, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Lane closure along Golden State Boulevard between Richert and Swift avenues in Fresno for curb and gutter work.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.

Work is scheduled to begin Monday, March 2 and will continue through Tuesday, March 17, 2026.
