

# **CONSTRUCTION ALERT**

## Multiple Closures Along Herndon Ave And Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along Herndon Avenue, Golden State Boulevard, and State Route (SR) 99 in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting Sunday, Jan. 14 and will continue through Wednesday, March 13, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

### **Closure And Detour Information:**

#### **Multiple Closures:**

- Intermittent lane closures along Herndon Ave, between Parkway and Riverside Dr;
- Lane closure along Riverside Dr, south of Herndon Ave;
- Lane closure along GSB, between Kathryn and Herndon Ave;
- Lane closure along SR99 Herndon off-ramp.

Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting Sunday, Jan. 14 and will continue through Wednesday, March 13, 2024.

#### **Northbound Herndon Ave Detour**

Traffic along Kathryn Ave heading north on Golden State Boulevard (GSB) will be detoured south on GSB, north on Herndon Ave, U-turn at Riverside Dr, straight along Herndon Ave, back onto GSB.

#### **Westbound Herndon Ave Truck Detour**

Truck traffic along State Route (SR) 99 off-offramp heading west on Herndon Ave will be detoured west on Herndon Ave, south on GSB, west on Shaw Ave, north on Grantland back onto Herndon Ave.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.
