

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Road Closure Along Market And State Streets In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a road closure along Market and State streets between Mission Avenue and Golden State Boulevard in Fresno for utility work. Work will continue through Friday, April 5, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Closures:

- Road closure along Market Street between Mission Avenue and Golden State Boulevard;
- Road closure along State Street between Mission Avenue and Golden State Boulevard.

Work will continue through Friday, April 5, 2024.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained for all business and property owners.
