



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Multiple Closures Along Thomas, Safford, And Belmont Avenues In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along Thomas, Safford, and Belmont avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Tuesday, Feb. 20 and will continue through Thursday, May 16, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Closures:

- Road closure along Thomas Avenue, between Thorne and Safford avenues;
- Road closure along Safford Avenue, between Belmont and Thomas avenues;
- Intermittent lane closures along Belmont Avenue, between Weber and Palm avenues.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Tuesday, Feb. 20 and will continue through Thursday, May 16, 2024.

Eastbound Belmont Avenue Detour
Traffic going northbound on H Street to eastbound Belmont Avenue will be detoured north on Palm Avenue to Belmont Avenue.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.



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
