

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Lane Closures Along Golden State Boulevard And East Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane closures along northbound Golden State Boulevard, between Church and Jensen Avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, Feb. 12 and will continue through Friday, April 19, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Lane closures along Golden State Boulevard between Church and Jensen avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, Feb. 12 and will continue through Friday, April 19, 2024.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.
