Permanent Road Closure Along Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a permanent road closure along Golden State Boulevard, between Belmont and Olive avenues in Fresno for work on the high-speed rail corridor. Closure will go into effect on Monday, March 4, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Permanent road closure along Golden State Boulevard between Belmont and Olive avenues in Fresno for work on the high-speed rail corridor. The road closure will go into effect on Monday, March 4, 2024.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic.

Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.
