

# **CONSTRUCTION ALERT**

## Multiple Closures Along Olive And Weber Avenues In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closure along Olive and Weber avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to continue through Friday, Sept. 5, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

## **Closure And Detour Information:**

### **Multiple Closures:**

- Intermittent lane and shoulder closures along Weber Avenue, north of Olive Avenue:
- Lane closure along Olive Avenue, between Weber and Fruit avenues.

Work is scheduled to continue through Friday, Sept. 5, 2025.

#### **Northbound Weber Avenue Detour**

Traffic heading to northbound Weber Avenue from Olive Avenue will be detoured northbound on Golden state Boulevard to Clinton Avenue.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained for all businesses and property owners.
