



# CONSTRUCTION ALERT

## Multiple Closures Along Olive And Weber Avenues In Fresno

**Fresno, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closure along Olive and Weber avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to continue through Friday, Sept. 5, 2025.

*This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.*

### Closure And Detour Information:

#### Multiple Closures:

- Intermittent lane and shoulder closures along Weber Avenue, north of Olive Avenue;
- Lane closure along Olive Avenue, between Weber and Fruit avenues.

**Work is scheduled to continue through Friday, Sept. 5, 2025.**

#### Northbound Weber Avenue Detour

Traffic heading to northbound Weber Avenue from Olive Avenue will be detoured northbound on Golden state Boulevard to Clinton Avenue.

**Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained for all businesses and property owners.**



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
