



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Lane Closure Along Northbound Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a lane closure along northbound Golden State Boulevard in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Monday, March 25, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Lane closure along northbound Golden State Boulevard, between State Route (SR) 99 on-ramp and Pine Avenue in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Monday, March 25, 2024.

Northbound Golden State Boulevard Truck Detour

Truck traffic heading northbound along Golden State Boulevard will be detoured east on McKinley Avenue, north on West Avenue, then east on Clinton Avenue onto Golden State Boulevard.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.



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
