

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

INTERMITTENT TRAFFIC IMPACTS ON EAST, AMERICAN, CHESTNUT AND MANNING AVENUES IN FRESNO COUNTY

Fresno County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along East, American, Chestnut and Manning Avenues in Fresno County to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site. Work is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, May 20 through Friday, June 14, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along East, American, Chestnut and Manning avenues in Fresno County to transport materials to a highspeed rail construction site. Work is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, May 20 through Friday, June 14, 2024.

Haul Route Materials will be transported south on East Avenue, east on American Avenue, south on Chestnut Avenue and west on Manning Avenue. Drivers may experience delays. Access will be maintained to all property and business owners.
