

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Road Closure Along Hanford Armona Road In Kings County

Kings County, Calif. –The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces a road closure along Hanford Armona Road, between State Route (SR) 43 and Seventh Avenue in Kings County for construction of a high-speed rail structure. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, June 24, 2024 and will continue through August 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Road closure along Hanford Armona Road, between SR 43 and Seventh Avenue in Kings County for construction of a high-speed rail structure.

Work is scheduled to begin Monday, June 24, 2024 and will continue through August 2025.

Eastbound Traffic

Traffic going eastbound on Hanford Armona Road will be detoured south on SR 43, east on Houston Avenue, north on Seventh Avenue, then east on Hanford Armona Road.

Westbound Traffic

Traffic going westbound on Hanford Armona

Road will be detoured south on Seventh Avenue, west on Houston Avenue, north on SR 43, then west on Hanford Armona.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic.

Access will be maintained for all property
and business owners.
