



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Lane And Shoulder Closures Along Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane and shoulder closures along Golden State Boulevard, near Jensen Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to begin Tuesday, Jan. 20, and will continue through Wednesday, Feb. 11, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Closures:

- Lane closure along southbound Golden State Boulevard south of Jensen Avenue;
- Shoulder closure along northbound Golden State Boulevard south of Jensen Avenue.

Work is scheduled to begin Tuesday, Jan. 20, and will continue through Wednesday, Feb. 11, 2026.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and residents.
