## Lane And Shoulder Closures Along Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane and shoulder closures along Golden State Boulevard, south of Veterans Boulevard in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, June 24 and will continue through Monday, July 8, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

## **Closure And Detour Information:**

Lane and shoulder closures along Golden State Boulevard, south of Veterans Boulevard in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, June 24 and will continue through Monday, July 8, 2024.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic.
