Nighttime Lane Closures Along Belmont Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces nighttime lane closures along Belmont Avenue, between Arthur and Delno avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting Sunday, Oct. 13 through Friday, Oct. 25, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Nighttime lane closures along Belmont Avenue, between Arthur and Delno avenues in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting Sunday, Oct. 13 through Friday, Oct. 25, 2024.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Pedestrian access will be restricted in some areas. Access will be maintained to all property and business owners in the area.
