

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Road Closures Along Cornelia And Mission Avenues In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple road closures along Cornelia and Mission avenues in Fresno for roadwork. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, Aug. 12 and will continue through Wednesday, Nov. 27, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Road Closures In Fresno For Roadwork:

- Road closure along Cornelia Avenue, between Shaw Avenue and Golden State Boulevard;
- Road closure along Mission Avenue, west of Cornelia Avenue.

Work is scheduled to begin Monday, Aug. 12 and will continue through Wednesday, Nov. 27, 2024.

Northbound Cornelia Avenue Detour

Traffic going eastbound along Shaw Avenue to northbound Cornelia Avenue will be detoured north on Golden State Boulevard, then west onto Cornelia Avenue.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.
