Multiple Closures Along Golden State Boulevard And Kathryn Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along Golden State Boulevard and Kathryn Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to continue through Friday, Dec. 6, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.


Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Closures:

- Southbound lane closure along Golden State Boulevard between State Route (SR) 99 and Kathryn Avenue;
- Road closure along Kathryn Avenue at Golden State Boulevard.

Work is scheduled to continue through Friday, Dec. 6, 2024.

Access will be maintained for all property owners and businesses. Signage will be in place to direct traffic.
