Intermittent Lane Closures Along Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces intermittent lane closures along Golden State Boulevard between Jensen and Orange avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work will continue through Friday, Oct. 4, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent lane closures along Golden State Boulevard, between Jensen and Orange avenues in Fresno for utility work.

Work will continue through Friday, Oct. 4, 2024.

Southbound Golden State Boulevard Detour

Traffic going southbound along Golden State Boulevard will be detoured west on Jensen Avenue, south on East Avenue, east on North Avenue, north on Cedar Avenue

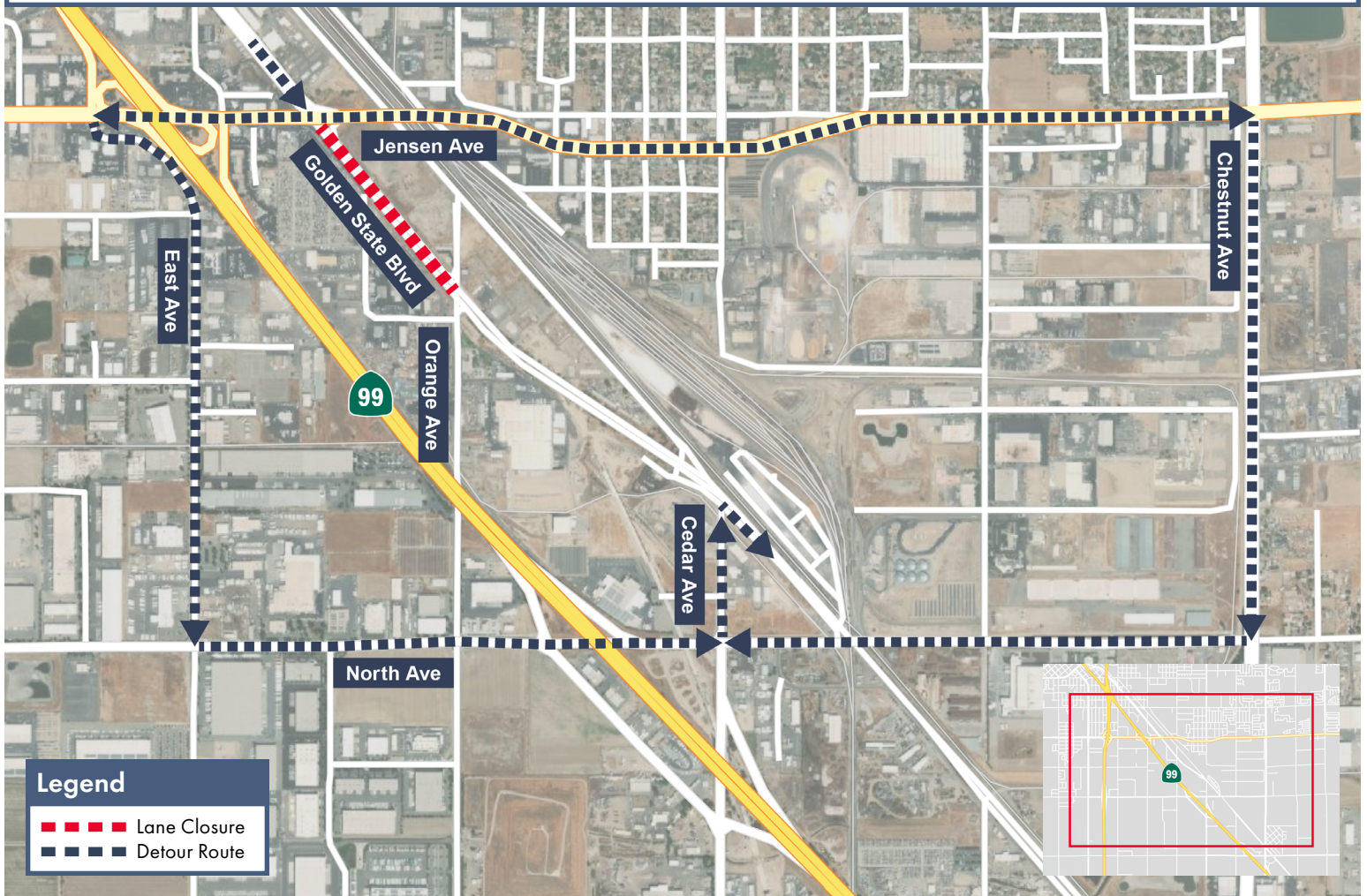
onto Golden State Boulevard.

Southbound Golden State Boulevard Detour

Traffic going southbound along Golden State Boulevard will be detoured east on Jensen Avenue,

south on Chestnut Avenue, west on North Avenue, north on Cedar Avenue onto Golden State Boulevard.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and residents.



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
