Intermittent Lane Closures Along Olive Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces intermittent lane closures along Olive Avenue, between Golden State Boulevard and West Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting Monday, Sept. 16 through Tuesday, Nov. 5, 2024.

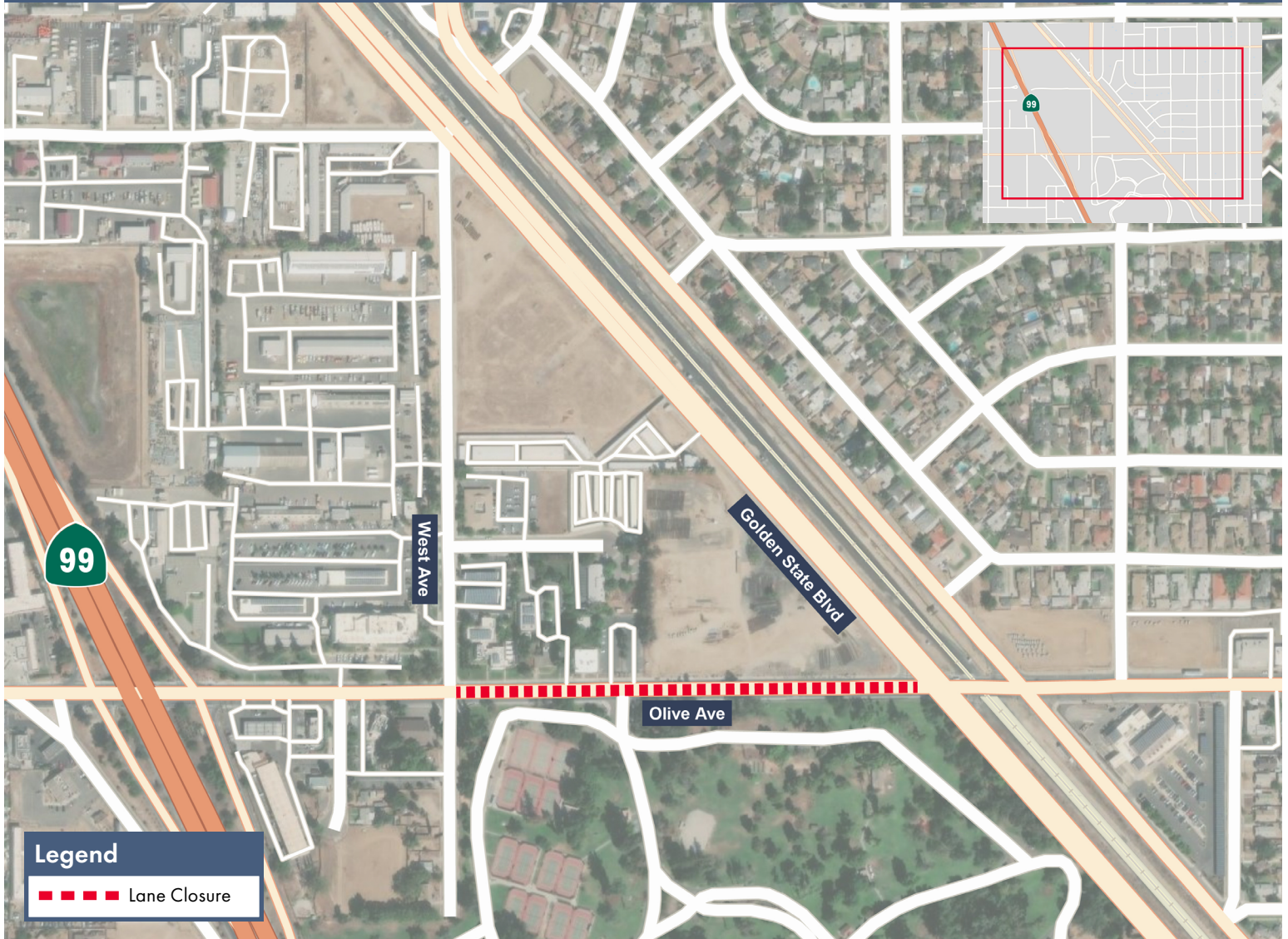
This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent lane closures along Olive Avenue between Golden State Boulevard and West Avenue in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 p.m. starting Monday, Sept. 16 through Tuesday, Nov. 5, 2024.
