

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Lane Closures Along G Street In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces intermittent lane closures along G Street, between Divisadero and El Dorado streets in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. from Monday, Sept. 30, through Friday, Nov. 1, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent lane closures along G Street, between Divisadero and El Dorado streets in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. from Monday, Sept. 30, through Friday, Nov. 1, 2024.

Eastbound El Dorado Street To Northbound G Street Detour Traffic will be detoured south on G Street, west on Stanislaus Street, south on E Street, then east on Tuolumne Street onto G Street. Northbound G Street To Westbound El Dorado Street Detour Traffic will be detoured west on Stanislaus Street, then north on E Street onto El Dorado Street.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.
