

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Intermittent Lane Closures Along Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces intermittent lane closures along Golden State Boulevard between Barstow and San Madele avenues in Fresno for road work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Wednesday, Nov. 26, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent lane closure along Golden State Boulevard between Barstow and San Madele avenues in Fresno for road work.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Wednesday, Nov. 26, 2025.
