

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Nighttime Lane Closures Along Golden State Boulevard And Shaw Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple nighttime lane closures along Golden State Boulevard and Shaw Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting Sunday, Oct. 20 through Friday, Nov. 1, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Nighttime Closures:

- Intermittent lane closures along Golden State Boulevard, between Cornelia and Santa Ana avenues;
- Intermittent lane closures along Shaw Avenue, between Forestiere and Blythe avenues;
- Road closure along Cornelia Avenue, south of Shaw Avenue.

Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting Sunday, Oct. 20 through Friday, Nov. 1, 2024.

Flaggers and signage will be in place to

direct traffic. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.
