Intermittent Lane Closures Along Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces intermittent lane closures along Golden State Boulevard, between Herndon Avenue and Veterans Boulevard in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Friday, Oct. 25, 2024.

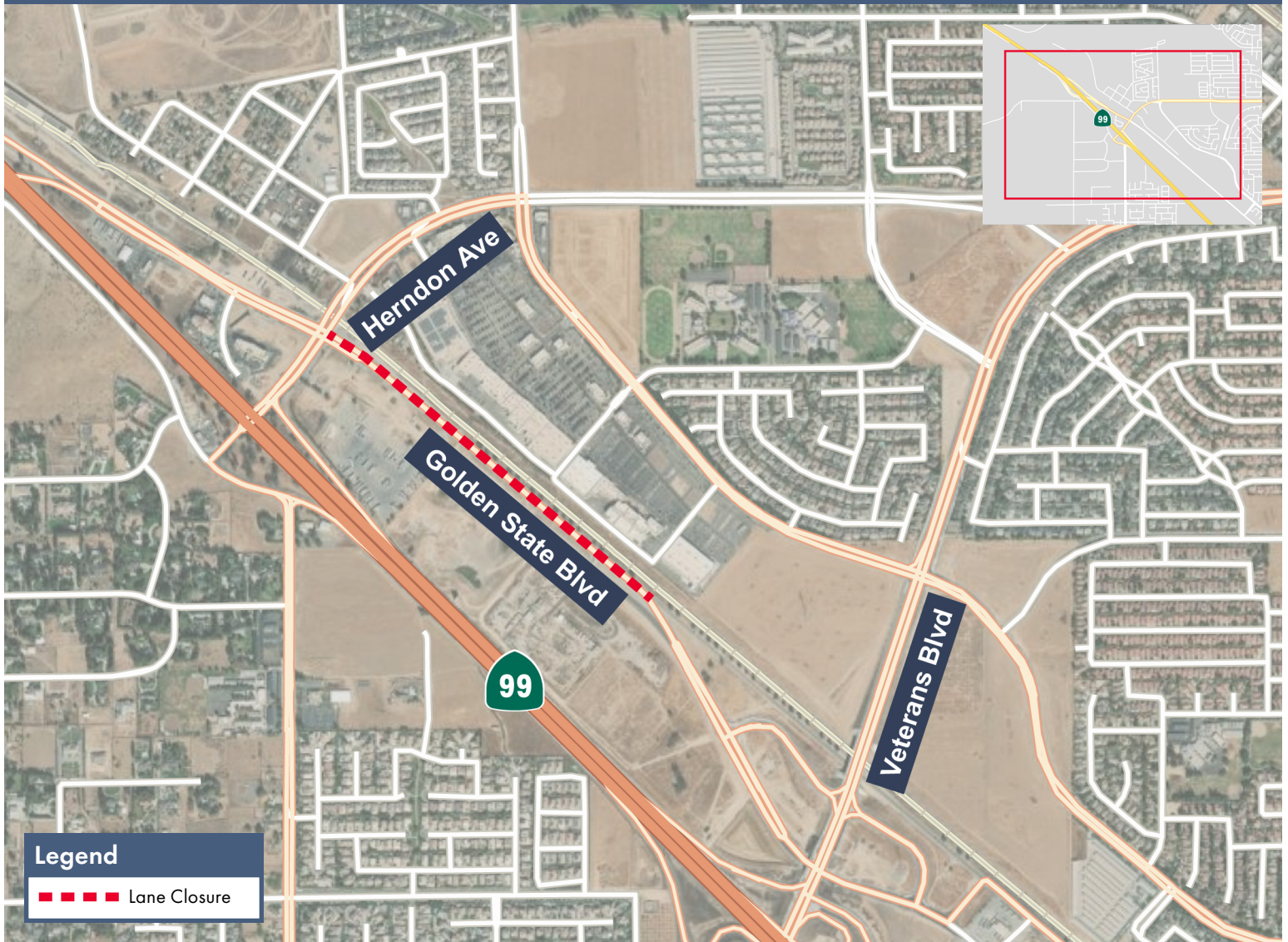
This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent lane closures along Golden State Boulevard, between Herndon Avenue and Veterans Boulevard in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Friday, Oct. 25, 2024.

Flaggers and signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained for all property and business owners.
