Intermittent Lane Closures Along Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces intermittent lane closures along Golden State Boulevard between Pine and Olive avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, Oct. 21, and will continue through Wednesday, Nov. 13, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent lane closures along Golden State Boulevard between Pine and Olive avenues in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled to begin Monday, Oct. 21, and will continue through Wednesday, Nov. 13, 2024.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.



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
