## Multiple Lane Closures Along Golden State Boulevard And Orange Avenue In Fresno

**Fresno, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple lane closures along Golden State Boulevard and Orange Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work will continue through Friday, Oct. 11, 2024.

*This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.*

### Closure And Detour Information:

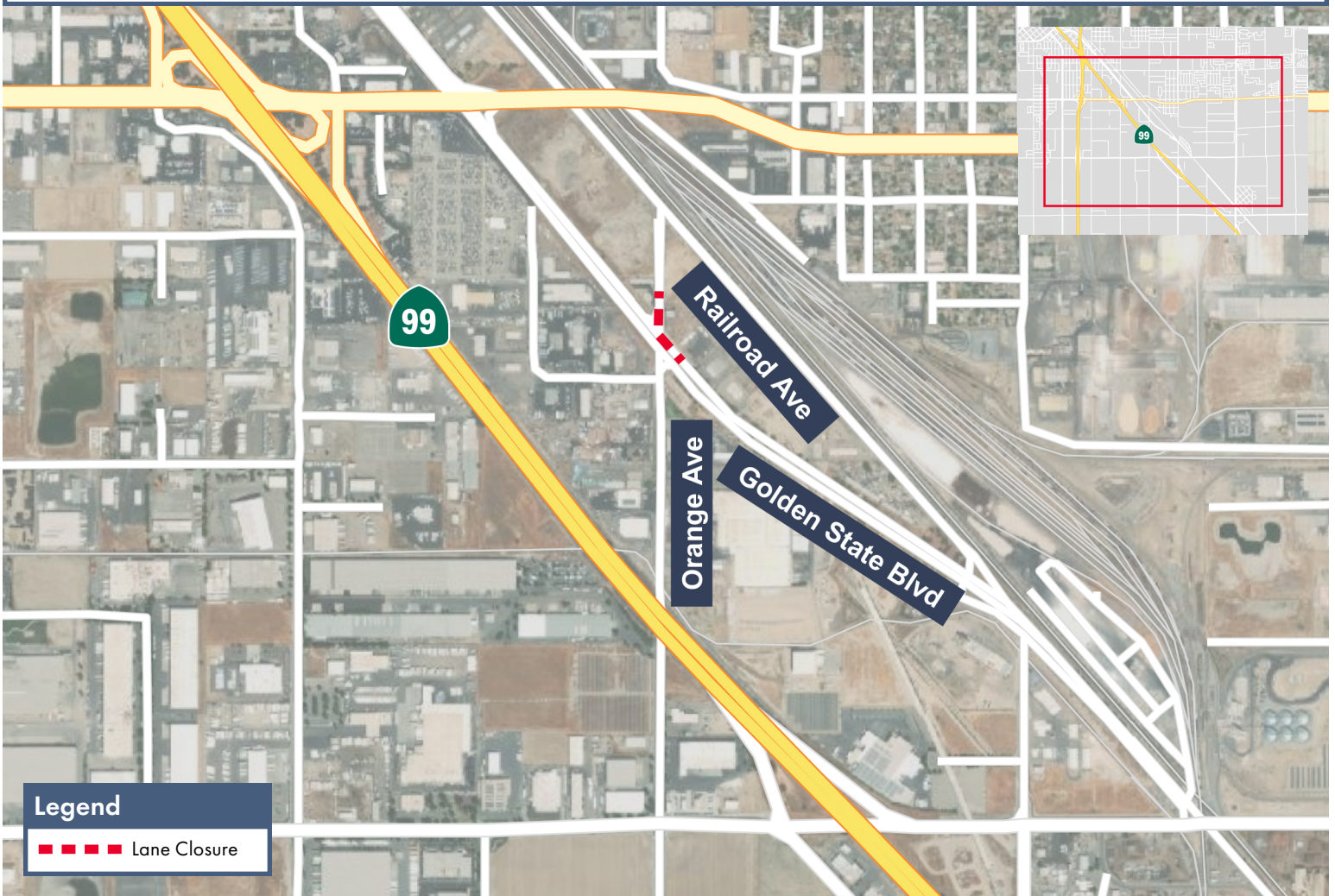
#### Multiple Lane Closures:

- Lane closure along northbound Golden State Boulevard, south of Orange Avenue.
- Lane closure along northbound Orange Avenue, between Golden State Boulevard and Railroad Avenue.
