

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Multiple Lane Closures Along Golden State Boulevard And Orange Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple lane closures along Golden State Boulevard and Orange Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work will continue through Friday, Oct. 11, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Lane Closures:

- Lane closure along northbound Golden State Boulevard, south of Orange Avenue.
- Lane closure along northbound Orange

Avenue, between Golden State Boulevard and Railroad Avenue.

Work will continue through Friday, Oct. 11, 2024.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic.

Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.
