Shoulder Closure Along Southbound Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a shoulder closure along southbound Golden State Boulevard, between Shaw and Santa Ana avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, Oct. 7 and will continue through Friday, Oct. 11, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Shoulder closure along southbound Golden State Boulevard between Shaw and Santa Ana avenues in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled to begin Monday, Oct. 7 and will continue through Friday, Oct. 11, 2024.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to driveways will be maintained for all property owners.
