Lane Closures Along Northbound Thorne Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane closures along northbound Thorne Avenue, between Napa and Voorman avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from Sunday, Oct. 13 and will continue through Thursday, Nov. 21, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Lane closures along northbound Thorne Avenue, between Napa and Voorman avenues in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled from Sunday, Oct. 13 and will continue through Thursday, Nov. 21, 2024.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.



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
