

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Multiple Road Closures Along Weber And Farrington Avenues In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple road closures along Weber and Farrington avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, Oct. 7 and will continue through Wednesday, Nov. 17, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Road Closures:

- Road closure along Farrington Avenue between Weber and Van Buren avenues from Monday, Oct. 7 through Wednesday, Oct. 16, 2024.
- Road closure along Weber Avenue between Herndon and Elgin avenues from Thursday, Oct. 17 through Wednesday, Nov. 13, 2024.

Work is scheduled to begin Monday, Oct. 7 and will continue through Wednesday, Nov. 17, 2024. This schedule is subject to change.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.
