Intermittent Traffic Impacts Along State Route 43 In Tulare County

Tulare County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along State Route (SR) 43, between Avenue 136 and Avenue 128 in Tulare County to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site. Hauling is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. starting Monday, Oct. 21 through Friday, Dec. 6, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along SR 43, between Avenue 136 and Avenue 128 in Tulare County to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site.

Hauling is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. starting Monday, Oct. 21, through Friday, Dec. 6, 2024.

Haul Route
Materials will be transported along SR 43 between Avenue 136 to Avenue 128.

Drivers may experience delays. Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.
