Lane And Shoulder Closures At Golden State Boulevard And San Madele Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane and shoulder closures at Golden State Boulevard and San Madele Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Nov. 18 through Friday, Nov. 29, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.
