

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Intermittent Lane Closures Along G Street In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces intermittent lane closures along G Street, between Santa Clara Street and Cesar Chavez Boulevard in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to begin Tuesday, Nov. 25, 2025, and will continue through Friday, Jan. 2, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent lane closures along G Street between Santa Clara Street and Cesar Chavez Boulevard in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled to begin Tuesday, Nov. 25, 2025, and will continue through Friday, Jan. 2, 2026.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all property and business owners.
